Key Points:

Keep it dainty, ethereal and whimsical

Flowers and herbs from the garden or farmer's market welcome

Use a mix of textures, including flowers, fillers and fine foliage
For a truly "antique-look" keep colors muted in color

Don't fight the colors of your container; work with them

Experiment with foam, frogs, tape and other materials to make
your container hold flowers in the best way possible

Accent with pearls, feathers, brushed metallics, antique cake
stands, floral-patterned fabrics, costume jewelry, etc.

Mix & Match your vintage containers; bottles, Ball jars, candy dishes,
vases, etc.; they all can work together to make a cohesive statement

Feel free to add fruit (dried and fresh) and other dried materials
like branches, pods, grapevine, moss, etc.
